NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

NOTE 1

Nature of Activities

Hamsadhwani Carnatic Music Academy of Southern California is a charitable organization that invites talented musicians from the United States of America and from India to perform classical musical concerts that enriches the listening experiences of the public. Our mission is to promote and create a vibrant community of Indian Classical Music lovers.

NOTE 2

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared by applying the not the profit generally accepted accounting principles (US GAAP). Under the statement of financial accounting standards (SFAS) No 117 Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Organizations, the Organization is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

Unrestricted Net Assets can be spent at the discretion of the Board of Directors. The organization has no temporarily restricted and permanently restricted net assets.

NOTE 3

Contributions

Under SFAS No. 116, Accounting for Contributions Received and Contributions Made: contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted net assets depending on the absence or existence and nature of any donor restrictions. Some of the contributions are recognized as deferred and are reflected as deferred contributions in accompanying financial statements.

NOTE 4

Income Taxes

The organization is a not-profit organization and exempt from income tax under section 501(c) (3) of Internal revenue code.

NOTE 5

Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and Cash Equivalents reported on the statement of cash flows include all cash amounts. Cash and Cash Equivalents as of December 31, 2015 were comprised of general operating account.
